MyTheaterApps.com Adds the Plays of William Shakespeare to the Scene Partner Public Library. The Scripts are Formatted Specifically for Use with the Scene Partner App. All of Shakespeare's Plays are Now Available for Immediate Download.

Why start with plays from the Elizabethan era? Shakespeare scholar Harold Bloom wrote, “...readers (and playgoers) find more vitality both in Shakespeare's words and in the characters who speak them than in any other author, perhaps in all other authors put together.” (*Shakespeare, The Invention of the Human*, p. 10)

Actors, writers and theater companies that use Scene Partner to solve the age-old problem of [how to memorize lines](#), now have access to all of Shakespeare's plays, optimized for use with the App and available for immediate download. The plays can be downloaded from the Scene Partner Public Library for the standard transmission fee of \$1.99 per script. Smith says, “In the coming months the number of scripts in the Library will continue to grow as the greatest plays from the Public Domain are evaluated, formatted and added to the collection.”

Scene Partner uses a Library structure to organize scripts for use in the App. Customers receive a secure Personal Library on the Scene Partner servers when they sign up for a free account. Customers can then use this Library to store their own scripts on a temporary basis for subsequent download to the Scene Partner App. The Public Library, on the other hand, is accessible to all Scene Partner customers from within the Scene Partner App and contains a growing list of Public Domain [scripts that have been optimized for use with Scene Partner](#).
